The Constitution of Virginia requires that you be registered to vote in the precinct in which you live in order to be qualified to vote.

The **deadline** to register to be eligible to vote in the in the June 2019 Primary is **Monday, May 20, 2019.**

Registered voters may vote In-Person in the Registrar's Office between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday thru Friday.
